


Corporate Housing Recommendations



Pets in San Diego

The City of San Diego has designated off leash parks for dogs to run free, play fetch and socialize with other dogs. In addition, these off leash parks protect your pets from rattlesnakes, ticks, and poison ivy that can be found in many of the trails and canyons throughout San Diego. As a gentle reminder, all dogs shall be maintained on a leash not to exceed 8-feet [in all parks]. Dogs must be leashed until inside the posted boundary for all of the off leash parks. The website has a detailed listing of approved leash free locations!
